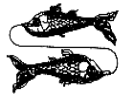

Annual membership runs from 1st April to 31st March and allows the use of two rods on:

15 stillwaters (no close season unless otherwise stated)

Ashman's Farm, Little Braxted	Dawn to dusk (closed 1 st October – 31 st January)
Beckingham Hall, Tolleshunt Major	5am to 10pm
Bog Grove, Great Totham	5am to 10pm
Howells Lake, Langford	5am to 10pm
Little London Lake, Goldhanger	No time restrictions
Little Park 1 & 2, Langford	5am to midnight
New Hall Reservoir, Purleigh	5am to 10pm (closed 1 st April – 30 th April)
Railway Pond, Heybridge	No time restrictions
Rook Hall 1, 2 & 3, Little Totham	Dawn to dusk (closed 1 st October – 31 st January)
Slough House Farm, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Totham Pit, Great Totham	5am to 10pm
Whitehouse Farm, Tolleshunt Darcy	5am to 10pm (closed 1 st October – 31 st January)

15 miles of rivers and canal (close season 15th March to 15th June inclusive)

Chelmer & Blackwater Canal from the Gasworks at Chelmsford to Heybridge Basin	No time restrictions
River Blackwater, Little Braxted (2 stretches)	Dawn to dusk
River Blackwater, Wickham Bishops / Langford	5am to 10pm

NIGHT FISHING PERMIT

For an additional £65 you can fish all of the above and also:

- Night fish at Totham Pit all year round
- Night fish at Howells Lake all year round
- Night fish at Beckingham Hall all year round
- Night fishing at Slough House Farm between 1st April and 31st October *
- Night fish at Bog Grove between 1st October and 30th April
- Use 3 rods between 1st October and 31st March on all venues

* The maximum length of a session on Slough House Farm is 2 days / 1 night followed by a 2 hour break. All other venues listed are 4 days / 3 nights followed by a 24 hour break.

Members under the age of 16 cannot buy a night permit. These must be purchased on their behalf by a current adult night permit holder. Juniors must be accompanied by an adult night permit member while fishing between the hours of 10pm and 5am and fish in the same swim as this adult between these times.

Guest tickets are available to non-members wishing to accompany a member to any of the above fisheries. Members can only take one guest per session at a cost of £8 per day (or £5 for an evening session). The cheaper rate also applies if the guest is under 16 years of age or qualifies for a concessionary membership of the Society. Guest tickets must be purchased in advance of fishing and do not give the guest permission to night fish.

Day tickets are only available on the Chelmer & Blackwater Canal. Prices on the bank are £6 for adults, £4.50 for concessions and £2 for juniors. Day tickets purchased in advance of fishing are priced £5 for adults and £3 for juniors / concessions.

New members can claim the value of their guest or day ticket as discount if they subsequently decide to join the society and the ticket is submitted with their application form.

A single night ticket costing £10 per night is also available to **existing members only**. These must be purchased in advance of fishing directly from the membership
