

Brick Kiln Pond at Inworth Now Open

We are pleased to announce that Brick Kiln Pond at Inworth is now open to members. This small fishery is located close to the A12 at Inworth and can be reached from Maldon by taking the B1022 to Tiptree and turning left at the double mini roundabouts onto the B1023 to Kelvedon. Continue passed Perrywoods Garden Centre until just before the bridge under the A12 where you should turn hard right into the entrance to Brick Kiln Farm. Our access is the gate on the right of the main gate into the parking area adjacent to the pond. Members travelling on the A12 should exit at Kelvedon and turn into Inworth Road from the B1024 before passing back under the A12 and turning immediately left into the entrance to Brick Kiln Farm.

Fishing is allowed from 5am to 10pm all year round with no night fishing. Please do not drive through the second gate that separates the car park from the pond. Members are asked to proceed with caution as the far bank is quite steep and to choose a sensibly strong line due to the healthy growth of lilies and pond weed.

The pond is known to contain a good head of silver fish along with carp to 10lb and some hard fighting brown goldfish.
