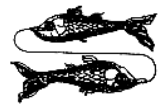

Spreading the cost: If your total fee is over £50 you can spread the cost by paying with 3 cheques, 2 of which are post-dated. 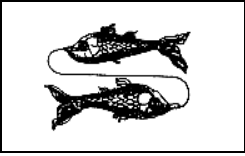
1. **Cheque(s) or postal order made payable to Maldon Angling Society**

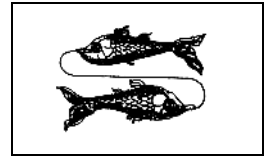

Annual membership runs from 1st April to 31st March and allows the use of two rods on:

14 stillwaters (no close season unless otherwise stated)

Bog Grove, Great Totham	5am to 10pm
Heron Hall, Tolleshunt Major	5am to 10pm
Little London Lake, Goldhanger	5am to 10pm
Little Park 1 & 2, Langford	5am to midnight
Railway Pond, Heybridge	No time restrictions
Rook Hall 1, 2 & 3, Heybridge	Dawn to dusk (closed 1 st October – 31 st January)
Slough House Farm, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Slough House West, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Totham Pit, Great Totham	5am to 10pm
Whitehouse Farm, Tolleshunt D'arcy	5am to 10pm (closed 1 st October – 31 st January)

14 miles of river and canal (close season 15th March to 15th June inclusive)

Chelmer & Blackwater Canal from the Gasworks at Chelmsford to Heybridge Basin	No time restrictions
River Blackwater, Wickham Bishops / Langford	5am to 10pm

NIGHT PERMIT (limited to 180)

For an additional £80 you can also night fish between 10pm and 5am at:

Totham Pit all year round

Little London all year round

Slough House Farm all year round *

Bog Grove between 1st October and 30th April

and use 3 rods between 1st October and 31st March on all venues.

* The maximum length of a session on Slough House Farm is 2 days / 1 night followed by a 24 hour break between 1st Apr and 31st Oct and 3 days / 2 nights followed by a 24 hour break between 1st Nov and 31st Mar. All other venues listed are 4 days / 3 nights followed by a 24 hour break.

Night permits are available to members who have a clean record with the society.

Junior night permits are also available priced £40 for siblings of adult night permit holders. These must be purchased on their behalf by a current adult night permit holder from the same household. Juniors must be accompanied by an adult night permit holder from the same household while fishing between the hours of 10pm and 5am and fish in the same swim as this adult between these times. Under 10's and Non-Fishing members are not allowed on society fisheries between 10pm and 5am.

If you want to fish an extra rod in the winter but do not want to night fish (or night permits are sold out) you can pay an additional **£30 for a winter 3 rod upgrade**.

Total membership is restricted to a maximum of 1,000 members.

Guest tickets are available subject to Covid-19 restrictions and membership numbers for non-members wishing to accompany a member and must be purchased in advance of fishing from the Membership Secretary, tackle shop or from our website. Guests are not allowed to night fish.

Day tickets are only available on the Chelmer & Blackwater Canal.

New members can claim the value of one guest/day ticket as discount if they subsequently decide to join the society and the ticket is submitted with their application form.
