

# The Railway Pond – Heybridge

## Day tickets available exclusively from JP Tackle

- This small fishery can be covered in surface duckweed during the warmer months so it is always worth visiting the pond for a quick look before purchasing a day ticket.
- If fishing between 16<sup>th</sup> June and 14<sup>th</sup> March your day ticket is also valid on the nearby Chelmer & Blackwater Canal.
- Please park sensibly in the spur road next to the pond.
- Stocked with small Tench, Roach, Crucian and Ghost Carp. No Close Season.

### Rules

1. Fishing allowed between 5am and 10pm (night fishing for season ticket holders only).
2. The use of cereal groundbait and peanuts is forbidden.
3. Day ticket holders must at all times comply with Environment Agency rules and be in possession of a valid EA Rod Licence.
4. A maximum of two rods can be used.
5. Your swim must be kept litter free at all times.
6. The cutting down of reeds, vegetation and trees is not allowed.
7. No fish can be killed or removed from the fishery. If using a keepnet fish must not be kept in captivity for longer than 6 hours and any fish showing signs of distress must be released upon demand of a Society bailiff.
8. Camping is not allowed.
9. Under no circumstances are fires allowed by the waterside or on any property on which Maldon Angling Society has fishing control.
10. Dogs, except guide dogs, are forbidden.
11. The presence of guns is strictly prohibited.
12. Radios are prohibited unless used with an ear piece adaptor or headphones.
13. No bait to be discarded at the end of a fishing session.
14. No fixed weights of greater than one ounce.
15. The use of live fish baits is not permitted.
16. No fishing more than halfway across the pond towards another angler.
17. Fishing hook/bait to be removed from the water when the swim is vacated for any reason.
18. Carp sacks are banned and carp over 5lb shall not be retained by any method.
19. Whilst fishing all anglers must be in possession of a landing net and suitable unhooking mat.
20. Day ticket anglers fish entirely at their own risk. Maldon Angling Society will not accept any responsibility or liability for the loss or damage to any tackle, property or personal possessions.
21. Day ticket holders must not be inconsiderate or abusive towards others whilst on property leased by the Society (includes excessive noise).
22. No boats to be used including bait boats and other radio controlled devices.
23. Braided main lines are banned. Leadcore lines are banned for all uses.
24. We recommend that you are in possession of a fish care product such as Klinik.
