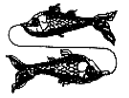

Winter membership runs from 1st October to 31st March and allows the use of two rods on the following **12** stillwaters:

Bog Grove, Great Totham	5am to 10pm
Brick Kiln Pond, Inworth	5am to 10pm
Heron Hall, Tolleshunt Major	5am to 10pm
Howells Lake, Langford	5am to 10pm
Little London Lake, Goldhanger	5am to 10pm
Little Park 1 & 2, Langford	5am to midnight
New Hall Reservoir, Purleigh	5am to 10pm
Railway Pond, Heybridge	No time restrictions
Slough House Farm, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Slough House West, Heybridge	5am to 10pm
Totham Pit, Great Totham	5am to 10pm

and **14 miles of river and canal** up until the 14th March:

Chelmer & Blackwater Canal from the Gasworks at Chelmsford to Heybridge Basin	No time restrictions
River Blackwater at Wickham Bishops / Langford	5am to 10pm

Also from **1st February** you can use 2 rods on these 4 lakes:

Rook Hall 1, 2 & 3, Heybridge	Dawn to dusk
Whitehouse Farm, Tolleshunt Darcy	Dawn to dusk

STANDARD NIGHT PERMIT - limited to 120 people

Please check availability on our website before applying.

For an additional £32.50 you can night fish at Totham Pit, Slough House Farm*, Little London and Bog Grove and use 3 rods on all venues.

Howells night permits
are **SOLD OUT** for

* The maximum length of a session on Slough House Farm is 2 days / 1 night followed by a 24 hour break up until 31st Oct and then 3 days / 2 nights followed by a 24 hour break between 1st Nov and 31st Mar. Totham Pit, Little London and Bog Grove are 4 days / 3 nights followed by a 24 hour break.

Howells night fishing is **not** included on the standard night permit. New members to the club will not be considered for a Howells night permit until they have been an ordinary member with a clean record for at least 2 consecutive years and have held a standard night permit during the previous season. A waiting list is in operation for next season's Howells night permits which go on sale from 1st Apr 2017 (please check the website for more info).

Guest tickets are available to non-members wishing to accompany a member and must be purchased from the membership secretary, tackle shop or from the website using Paypal in advance of fishing. Guests are not allowed to night fish.

Day tickets are only available on the Chelmer & Blackwater Canal and Railway Pond.

New members can claim the value of their guest or day ticket as discount if they subsequently decide to join the society and the ticket is submitted with their application form.
